To celebrate King Charles III's Coronation, British Embassy The Hague invites all children aged 11 and under who are living in the Netherlands to take part in this fun competition.

Guidelines on How to Enter:

- There are three age categories: 3 5, 6 8, and 9 11 years.
- The artwork can be either a drawing or a painting, not larger than an A4 sized sheet of paper.
- Only one drawing or painting may be submitted.
- The artwork must be related to King Charles III's Coronation and we encourage applicants to think about making a link to the Netherlands.
- The artwork should be sent digitally to our mailbox (ukinnlart@fcdo.gov.uk) e.g.
 take a photo of your artwork and share this with us with the <u>Subject Line</u>:
 <u>"Coronation Children's Art Competition Age Group: [insert]"</u>
- Please also provide your name of the applicant and guardian in the email to us.
- The deadline for submitting artworks is Friday 28 April, 17:00 (CET).
 Participants should be resident in the Netherlands on this date.

The Prize:

Prize winners will be welcomed to the Ambassador's Residence in The Hague to enjoy a cup of tea with Joanna Roper CMG, British Ambassador to the Netherlands, together with their parent or legal guardian. The winning entries will be printed, framed, and displayed within The British Embassy in The Hague.

Winners will be announced on Friday 5 May.
