Museum Beelden aan Zee is the only museum in the Netherlands that is entirely dedicated to modern and contemporary (inter)national sculpture. In a special building, hidden in the dunes of Scheveningen, you will discover works of art that come to life both indoors and outdoors. In addition to the permanent collection, the museum always presents surprising, temporary exhibitions. The unique location by the sea and the play of light, space and nature make every visit a special experience.

The museum offers inspiring educational programs for all levels of education. Each museum lesson is carefully designed to stimulate students' curiosity, stimulate their imagination and actively connect them with visual art. With *Sensory Sculpture*, we invite students to experience sculpture in a whole new way. Not only looking, but also feeling, smelling and listening: this unique experience makes art tangible and unforgettable.

For primary education, our lessons are in line with the learning lines of *Cultural Education the Hague way*. In secondary education, classes can choose from various guided tours and in-depth workshops, tailored to age and learning objectives. In addition, a tailor-made program is always possible: together we create a lesson that suits your group.

Ryan Gander X Edgar Degas – Pas de Deux until 4 January 2026

The exhibition in Museum Beelden aan Zee connects the iconic sculpture *Petite Danseuse de Quatorze Ans* by Edgar Degas with the contemporary reinterpretations of artist Ryan Gander. Whereas in the 19th century Degas captured the young ballerina in a vulnerable and realistic pose – a turning point in the transition from classical to modern sculpture – Gander questions this representation more than a century later. In his playful, poetic sculptures, he frees the ballerina from her fixed role and places her in recognizable, everyday situations.

For education, this exhibition offers rich starting points for talking to students about themes such as youth, identity, role patterns, physicality and the influence of art on image formation. The combination of historical perspective and contemporary interpretation invites critical thinking and creative reflection. Bringing Degas and Gander together creates a powerful pedagogical moment: students discover how art evolves with the times and learn to look beyond the apparent.
